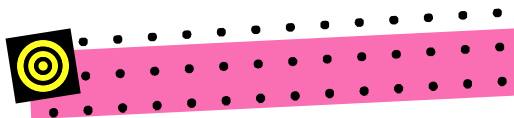
It is the mission of the Foundation to teach these positive life skills to all who participate in its programs.
